



## Free Pattern: Baby Bird Quilt

I made a new free pattern for all of you who visit my blog. It is called the Baby Bird Quilt. I made it to hang in my own baby room soon. You can make this quilt in any size. If you follow the instructions the quilt will be 36 inch long and 27 inch wide. You can have it as a baby quilt on a bed or turn it into a baby card wall hanging by attaching small clothespins as I did!

**Step 1:** You will find the stitchery pattern of the birds attached. You need to put this together and enlarge this so it becomes 23 inch wide from birds' wing to birds' wing and 7.5 inch long.

**Step 2:** Trace the pattern on fabric and make the stitchery in your own embroidery threads. I just used matching scraps of thread. When finished cut the stitchery into the right size: 24.5 inch wide and 8.5 inch long. This will include seam allowance.

**Step 3:** Cut out 9 squares that are 8.5 inch x 8.5 inch and put them together in a 3x3 square formation.

**Step 4:** Attach the square made out of 3x3 blocks to the stitchery. I attached some zig-zag ribbon on the border between the 3x3 blocks and the stitchery. Attach a border as wide as you like to get the right size for you quilt or wall hanging. The border is 2.5 inch wide including seam allowance. Quilt it and you are done!

Have fun making this quilt as a wall hanging or as a baby quilt. I would love to see what you are making with the pattern so please leave me a comment or email me a picture!
