



# Waiting for Spring Mystery Quilt Part 2



For part 2 of this mystery quilt you will need to make small blocks like this.

You will need to make a total of 332 of these.

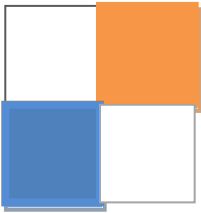
(Make one small block first and measure if you get the right size for the block which is 2 inch, before you cut everything)



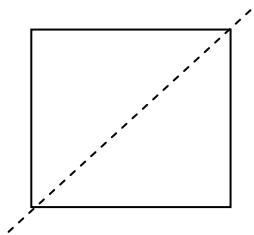
Out of your dark fabrics cut: 664 small squares that are 1 inch

Out of your light fabrics cut: 664 small squares that are 1 inch

You can also make strips that you piece together and cut so that you can make the 4-patch as shown below, using the fast strip piece technique.

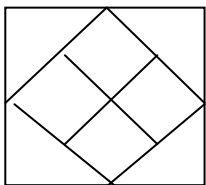


Put these together as small 4-patches. Note: When you put these together with a normal seam allowance it would be a bit too small. So make your blocks just a smidge larger. It needs to be  $1 \frac{1}{16}$  of an inch when finished. If you use your normal seam allowance it would be 1 inch finished which is just a bit too small.



Cut out of you light fabrics a total of 664 squares that are  $1 \frac{5}{8}$  and cut them on the diagonal.

Sew these around your 4-patches being careful to use a smaller seam allowance.



Your blocks need to be 2 inch when done.
