



Pink and Barbara



This little draw string bag is made with 2 different fabrics, an inside and an outside fabric.

You will need:

- *Outside fabric: one strip 30 cm x 70 cm or 10,5 inch x 26 inch*
- *Inside fabric: one strip 25 cm x 70 cm or 9 inch x 26 inch*
- *A piece of string or cord*
- *Eyelets (rings) or be able to make button holes on your sewing machine*
- *Normal sewing supplies like matching thread, scissors etc.*

The Pattern:

The pattern is 1/2 of your whole pattern piece. It has seam allowances included. You can resize the pattern in every size you would like since seam allowances are included, but this is the largest size possible on normal paper. If you want a larger ruffle look at the pattern where you need to add extra fabric.

- *The outside bag is bigger than the inside bag. Cut the pattern out. Fold your fabric in half. Place the pattern on the fold and cut this out 2 times.*
- *The inner bag is smaller than the outside bag so cut or fold the pattern on the line marking the inside bag on the pattern. Fold your fabric in half. Place the pattern on the fold and cut this out 2 times.*

Preparation:

Take one piece of your outside bag pieces. Mark the placement of the rings or the button holes and make them. If you use rings make sure to put a piece of stabilizer behind the rings.

Sewing:

Put the 2 pieces of the inner fabric right sides together and do the same with outside bag. Sew all the side seams and all the bottom seams but leave a small hole for turning on the bottom seam of the inside bag. Do not sew the corner seams. Now fold the side seams onto the bottom seam. This makes the corner seams form a straight line. Sew these seams, and your two bags are done.

Now take the inside bag, wrong side facing out and put the outside bag into it, with the outside out. The right sides of both bags should be touching each other. Now pin the top of the inside and outside bags together and sew. Turn the bag using the small hole you left in bottom of the inside bag. A piece of the outside will be folded in. Sew a seam over the seam you have connecting the inside and outside bags just under your rings or your button holes and a seam above the rings or button holes as well. Put the string through the holes and between these 2 seams which now make a tunnel. Sew the small hole in the bottom of the bag shut by hand and the bag is done!

add more fabric if you want a big ruffle.
